<a href="#">Flash Drive</a>	Ideally with a string or lanyard. At least 1GB of storage.	1	All Subjects
<a href="#">2 Inch-Thick, Three-Ring Binders</a> , Heavy Duty, with Clear Cover Pocket and Pockets for papers Inside.	We highly recommend that you purchase three binders of the 2 inch size. Three binders of this size will fit perfectly next to each other in the width of your locker!	3	All Subjects
<a href="#">1 Inch Thick, Three Ring Binder</a>	Similar to above, but needed for Physical Education.	1	Physical Education
<a href="#">1 Inch Thick, Three Ring Binder</a>	Binder with clear cover pocket and pockets on the inside	1	
<a href="#">1 Inch Thick, Three Ring Binder with 4 tabs</a>	Similar to above.	1	Writer's Workshop
<a href="#">4 Inch-Thick, Three- Ring Binder</a> (optional, but highly-recommended)	In addition to the three binders noted above, we highly recommend that you have a large binder that you keep at home to put older materials from each binder when they start to fill up. That way, you will be able to retain all your materials from each class for the whole year, but your binders won't overflow!	1	All Subjects
<a href="#">Binder Dividing Tabs</a>	You will need at least 21 dividing tabs that you will use in your binders organized. 21 of those tabs are required and will be used in your smaller binders at school (two tabs for each course). We also recommend another 10 tabs to you use in your large, 4 inch binder at home to mark each course when you put older materials in that binder.	21-31	All Subjects
