



FINANCIAL GRANT CHECKLIST

Visitation is committed to working with families to help provide a Visitation education for their children. We seek a diversified student body, which brings to the school students with many different talents and experiences from a variety of socioeconomic, religious and ethnic backgrounds.

For the 2019-20 school year, Visitation committed more than \$1.5 million to the need-based financial grant program. Students in kindergarten through grade 12 are eligible to apply for these funds, and approximately 30 percent receive a financial grant. All awards are based on demonstrated need, with the Financial Grant Committee reviewing each case individually.

To apply for a financial grant, please follow the checklist below:

PARENTS OF STUDENTS ENTERING KINDERGARTEN-GRADE 12

- Complete the Parents Financial Statement through the SSS financial grant application and submit, with fee, by February 14, 2020.

FAMILIES WHO ARE APPLYING FOR A GRANT AT VISITATION FOR THE FIRST TIME

- Upload a copy of your 2019 W2 Forms to the SSS application by February 14, 2020.
- Upload a complete copy of your 2017 and 2018 Federal and State Income Tax Returns (Forms 1040 and MN M1, related schedules including partnership and Subchapter S returns, and copies of W-2 forms) to the SSS Application by February 14, 2020. The Financial Grant Committee cannot consider a grant for your child without these forms.

FAMILIES WHO RECEIVED A FINANCIAL GRANT AT VISITATION FOR THE 2019-20 SCHOOL YEAR

- Upload a copy of your 2019 W2 Forms to the SSS application by February 14, 2020.
- Upload a complete copy of your 2018 Federal and State Income Tax Returns (Form 1040 and MN M1, related schedules including partnership and Subchapter S returns, and copies of W-2 forms) to the SSS Application by February 14, 2020. The Financial Grant Committee cannot consider a grant for your child without these forms.

Note: If you are divorced or separated, the non-custodial parent must also complete the online grant applications. The non-custodial parent must also submit copies of his/her 1040 with all schedules, W-2 forms, a signed Form 4506, and business forms with appropriate tax returns. Please contact the Financial Grant Office with any questions at 651.683.1742.

In addition to Visitation financial grants, funding may also be available through the Catholic Services Appeal Foundation (kindergarten–grade 12) or the Aim Higher Foundation (kindergarten–grade 8). To apply for a grant from these organizations, complete the TADS financial grant application, with fee, by February 14, 2020.

In some circumstances, Visitation may require additional supporting documentation to complete the financial grant process.
